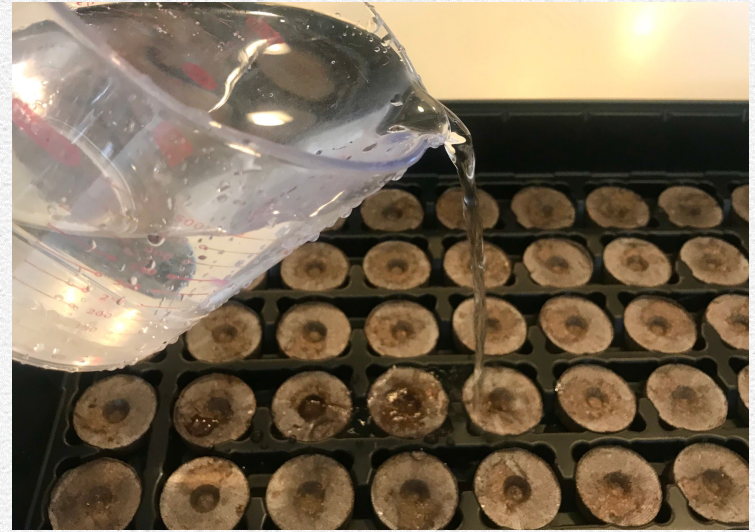

# Transplanting your seedling



## Transplanting Seedlings to Larger Pots

Select Mature Plant from Seed Tray  
(after snipping weaker plant(s))



Use 3- or 4-inch Pot



Fill base ½ inch with Potting Soil  
and Place Plant



Fill soil to ½ inch below container lip.  
Don't forget to water and label!

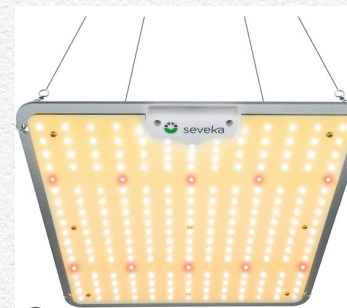
